



PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING



The Prince George's County Department of the Environment (DoE) will hold a public meeting to collect comments on the County's draft local total maximum daily load (TMDL) restoration plans designed to meet the County's permit requirements under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES). Under the permit, the County is to control pollutant discharges to the storm drain system using a multi-faceted approach, including developing and implementing restoration plans to address pollutant reduction goals established under approved TMDLs. Two draft plans for the Patuxent watershed will be presented at the meeting. Members of the public are invited to comment orally or in writing.
